

# Christmas Trivia Game!

1. If you totaled all the gifts given in the song The Twelve Days of Christmas, how many gifts would be given?

**B. 364 gifts.**

On the first day of Christmas a partridge in a pear tree = 1

2nd day – 2 turtle doves and a partridge = 3 + 1 partridge from day one = 4

3rd day – 3 hens, 2 doves, a partridge = 6 + 3 from day two and 1 from day one = 10

And so on... 364 presents altogether

Partridges:  $1 \times 12 = 12$

Doves:  $2 \times 11 = 22$

Hens  $3 \times 10 = 30$

Calling birds:  $4 \times 9 = 36$

Golden rings:  $5 \times 8 = 40$

Geese:  $6 \times 7 = 42$

Swans:  $7 \times 6 = 42$

Maids:  $8 \times 5 = 40$

Ladies:  $9 \times 4 = 36$

Lords:  $10 \times 3 = 30$

Pipers:  $11 \times 2 = 22$

Drummers:  $12 \times 1 = 12$

**Total = 364**
